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Project Background

Contract Title: Potomac Interceptor Project 1 (PI-01) – Anglers Inn / Cabin John

Delivery Method: Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR)

Approved Contract Budget: \$112M

Description:

Rehabilitation of approximately 10,300 feet of 72" - 96" reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) that spans from Manholes M-20 to M-11 along the Clara Barton Parkway. Inspections show concrete deterioration, rebar exposure and loss as well as corrosion in multiple areas. Project also includes the protection and resiliency of the PI crossing the Cabin John Creek. The rehabilitation and associated designs have progressed to a 60% level. A draft Environmental Assessment (EA) was submitted to the National Park Service.

Scope Elements:

- Rehabilitation of approximately 10,300 feet of 72"-96"" RCP using a Geopolymer
- Temporary bypass pumping with a capacity of up to 70 million gallons per day (MGD)
- Installation of suction and discharge chambers
- Resiliency design of the PI at the Cabin John Creek
- Traffic Control on Clara Barton Parkway
- Secure a Special Use Permit (SUP) with NPS
- Compliance with Environmental Assessment (EA)
- Public outreach coordination and communication

Milestones and Constraints:

- Request for Qualification/Proposal (RFQ/P): February 2025
- Notice to Proceed (NTP) by: February 2026
- Substantial Completion: September 2027
